- 5 Mrs. Edith Brown Haisman, the oldest survivor of the Titanic,
- 6 died at the age of 100 on January 20, 1997. She was 15 years old
- 7 when placed in Lifeboat #13 as the Titanic sank. Her father,
- 8 Thomas Brown, a glass of brandy in hand, waved from the deck
- 9 saying "I will see you in New York."
- 10 In 1993 she described her ordeal:
- 11 *"I was in Lifeboat #13. I always remembered that. My father was*
- 12 *waving to us and talking to a clergyman, the Rev. Carter."*
- 13 *"The Titanic went in the ice and I heard three bangs. Before we*
- 14 *hit, there had been terrific vibrations from the engines during the*
- 15 *night as the ship was really racing over the sea."*
- 16 *"As the lifeboat pulled away we heard cries from people left on*
- 17 *the Titanic and in the water and explosions in the ship. There*
- 18 *were lots of bodies floating ... We were in the lifeboat nine*
- 19 *hours."*
- 20 *"I kept looking in the water for my father and when we reached*
- 21 *New York we went to the hospitals to see if he had been picked*
- 22 *up."*
